Vintage Street Fair

Thank you for your interest in the Trash to Treasures vintage street fair hosted by the Sutter Creek Business & Professionals Association. This is a vintage street faire located in historic downtown Sutter Creek. There will be antique/vintage vendors along Eureka Street and in two parking lots. Vendors selling handmade or yard sale items will fill spaces along Randolph Street. We are happy to share that we're increasing the number of spaces along Randolph Street this year.

Antique vendors may sell antiques, collectibles and crafts made with repurposed or recycled vintage items. **At least 80% of the items in your booth should be considered vintage - at least 30 years old or older.** We are looking for vintage, mid-century or antique clothing, jewelry, furniture, home décor, architectural salvage, collectibles, art, books, western & garden items & wonderful old junk. Handmade items are just that – handmade by the person selling them. This is a vintage street fair so handmade items with a vintage look definitely seem to sell better.

PLEASE, NO vulgar, inappropriate or political items. This is a family friendly event. You will be asked to remove any inappropriate items

- Space fee is still only \$50 for an area approximately 10' x12'. Most spaces are the size of an average parking spot. This year we will be using the actual painted parking spaces when possible so sizes might be smaller from last year. You may request more than one space
- Setup starts at 5:30am. Vendors must unload items then park in designated parking area away from their booth
- You will receive a call/email confirming that your application has been received and accepted. I will send you an email a few days before the event with information on space number/location, set-up, parking, clean-up and general information about the event
- Every effort will be made to give previous vendors the same space but there is no guarantee.
- This is a rain or shine event. The Association is unable to have rain dates or give refunds or credits for booth spaces.
- There is no electricity available
