

Explore Sutter Creek

★ **Knight Foundry:** Established in 1873 by Samuel Knight, Knight Foundry is the last water-powered foundry and machine shop in America, and one of the nation's best preserved 19th-century industrial complexes. It is now a living industrial history museum and educational facility.

★ **Sutter Creek Historic Grammar School:** The school was opened in 1871. In 1976 it was added to the National Register of Historic Places as registered Historical Site #76000477. The school served up to 350 students through grade 8, from 1871 until 1965. The building is one of the last remaining two-story brick schoolhouses in the Mother Lode.

★ **Monteverde General Store:** Opened by John Monteverde and his son John, as a country store in 1896 and still displays all paraphernalia of the past on its shelves. Well preserved, it is now a museum.

★ *Choc-o-Latte: Enjoy a Free kids scoop with this Tour Card on the 2nd Saturday of every month.*

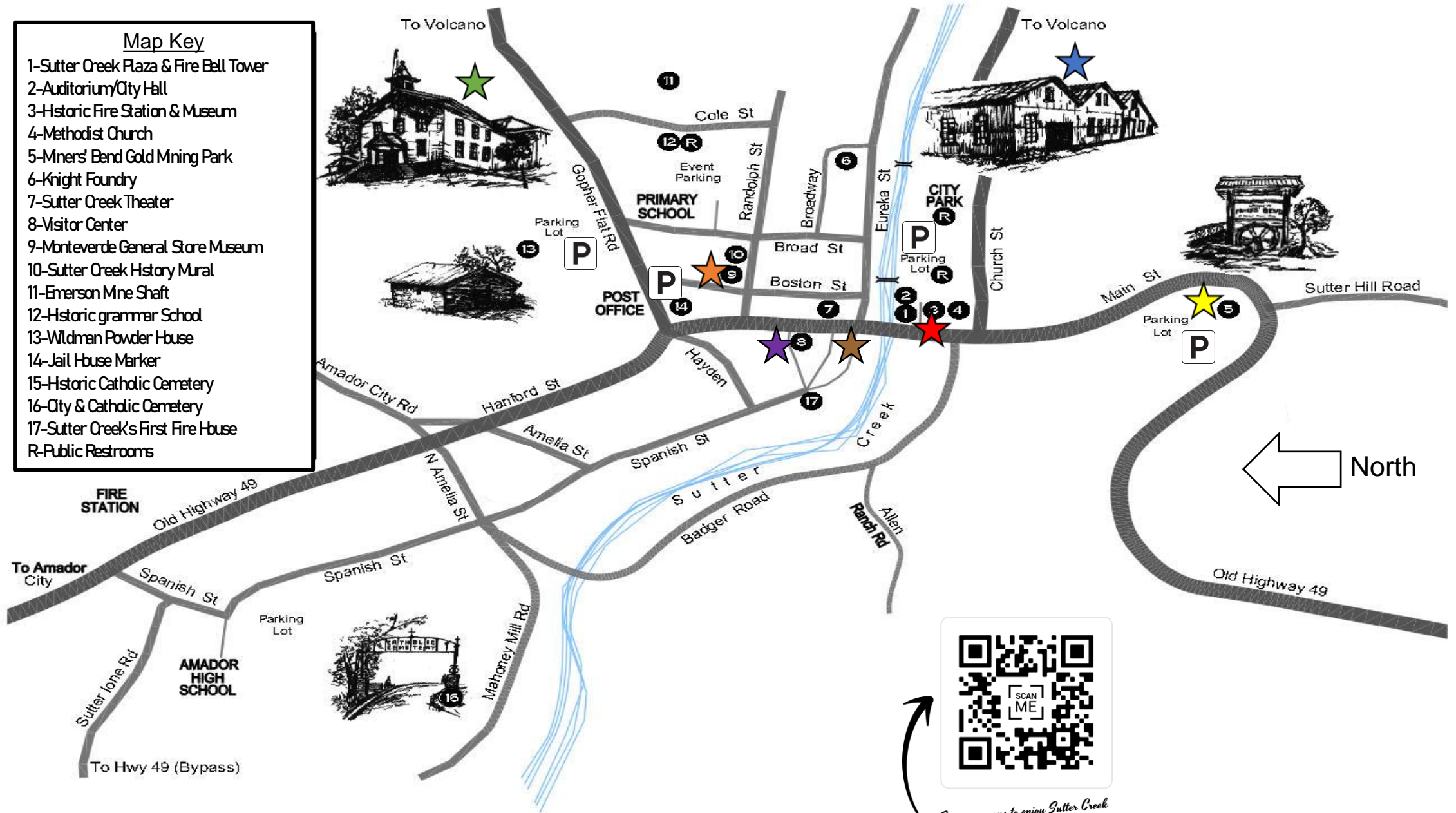
★ **Visitor Center:** The Brignole Building features extensive use of native stone and the familiar iron doors and shutters of Gold Rush architecture; it is one of the largest and oldest buildings in Sutter Creek. The northern part of the structure was built in 1859 by a man named Molinari. Brignole purchased Molinari's store and the lot south of it, upon which he constructed the rest of the building which remains today. He originally used the structure for a general store. Now it is a Visitor Center and Sutter Creek Store.

★ **Old Fire Station:** The old fire station on Main Street was built in the mid 1930s and used until 2016 and is now being developed as the Sutter Creek Fire Museum.

★ **Miners' Bend Historic Mining Park:** On June 1, 2015 work began with donations of money, materials for construction, labor, and artifacts from the Lincoln and Argonaut Mines to construct this amazing Gold Mining History Park.
